The above proposed start date may be subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances.

These works will be implemented between 08:00 hours and 17:00 hours (Monday to Saturday, weather permitting). Please note that footway areas will be maintained for use outside of these hours.

We are aware that these works may cause some disruptions to residents, local businesses and visitors; however we will endeavour to keep this to a minimum. The duration of works specified above is only indicative, we will endeavour to complete the works in the minimum time possible. It is possible; however, that the works will take longer than expected if we encounter any unforeseen difficulties for example bad weather.

In order for these works to be carried out in a safe working manner, the carriageway has to be kept clear from parked vehicles at the locations highlighted above. We will use 'No Waiting' cones and signs to indicate the extent of any parking restrictions. If a vehicle is obstructing the works the Council may relocate the vehicle. If you think your vehicle may have been towed or repositioned, try TRACE on 0845 206 8602 or go to <https://trace.london/> to find out. Clearly we would prefer not to do this so please try and observe the cones and signs accordingly.
