**Statutory Consultation – Bermondsey ‘G’ Controlled Parking Zone**

Between July and August 2019, we consulted on proposals to extend the operating hours of the Bermondsey ‘G’ controlled parking zone (CPZ). A majority of those who responded stated that they would like the CPZ operating hours to be extended. As a result, we are now taking proposals for CPZ ‘G’ to operate Monday to Sunday 8.30am to 11pm to statutory consultation. This is a statutory period of 21 days where we are legally required to publish the proposal to implement these changes with details on how you can make a representation for or against the changes. These notices are also published online at [www.southwark.gov.uk/trafficorders](http://www.southwark.gov.uk/trafficorders), in Southwark News and the London Gazette. Please either write to TMO Officer, Third Floor, Hub 2, 160 Tooley Street, SE1 2QH or [traffic.orders@southwark.gov.uk](mailto:traffic.orders@southwark.gov.uk) with the reference *TMO2122-011 CPZ G Review* and your street name by 10 September 2021.


The previous consultation, as mentioned above found that a majority of those who responded (58%) indicated they would like the operational hours to be changed, with 51% of respondents indicating they supported extending the zone to operate from Monday to Sunday. Further analysis of individual responses highlighted there was a majority in favour of extending the operating hours to either 24 hours or 8.30am to 11pm.

Once this 21 day statutory consultation period ends, we will present all representations to the Cabinet Member for Transport, Parks and Sport for a final decision on whether these can be implemented.
