REMINDER OF FILMING AT BUTLERS WHARF TUESDAY 17TH JANUARY 2023

Dear Resident / Business Manager / Owner,

We previously wrote to you to inform you that Oasis Productions Ltd are planning to film on Butlers Wharf on **Tuesday 17th January 2023**. The filming is for a new action/comedy film to be released on Netflix. Resident and business feedback is essential to us, and we have been in communication with Southwark Council regarding our plans and are committed to causing as little inconvenience as possible, please do get in touch if you have any queries or concerns.

This scene will involve drones; stunts/motorcycles on Butlers Wharf, permission has been granted by the relevant parties, we will also have boats on the River Thames. All motorcycles and boats will be controlled by qualified stunt personnel. We will also have imitation weapons, which will be under the supervision of a qualified armorer, we will have Police with us at all times during the filming.

Filming Schedule

Tuesday 17th January 2023

- Filming stunt sequence Butlers Wharf & Pier as per the following schedule:
 - Prep: 08:00 – 16:00
 - Shoot: 16:00 – 02:00

Wednesday 18th January 2023

- Clear location of all equipment, vehicles to depart location:
 - Strike: 08:00 – 12:00

Parking

In order to facilitate our filming, we have requested to suspend parking bays in the local vicinity, for the parking of essential technical vehicles (please see map overleaf), we have attempted to keep this to a minimum wherever possible. We will be providing alternative parking at Q-Park Tower Bridge for any residents that will be displaced due to our suspensions, please contact us directly should you require alternative parking.

Lighting Position / Road Closures

We will have lighting positions on land and on the river to light our filming area, this will include a rib boat on the River Thames containing LED strip lighting and reflectors.

During our filming hours public access along Butlers Wharf will be diverted; resident access will be maintained at all times, though you may be kindly asked to wait for short holds whilst the camera is rolling. There will be plenty of marshals, traffic management and security personnel on duty to help manage access. If requested, we are happy to supply ear plugs to any residents within the area.

We are working closely with Southwark Council and have notified various key stakeholders in the area in order to ensure all factors are taken into consideration with our planning.
